This sleek and graceful, yet strong and powerful 45m **Abeking & Rasmussen aluminium custom schooner** will take you anywhere.

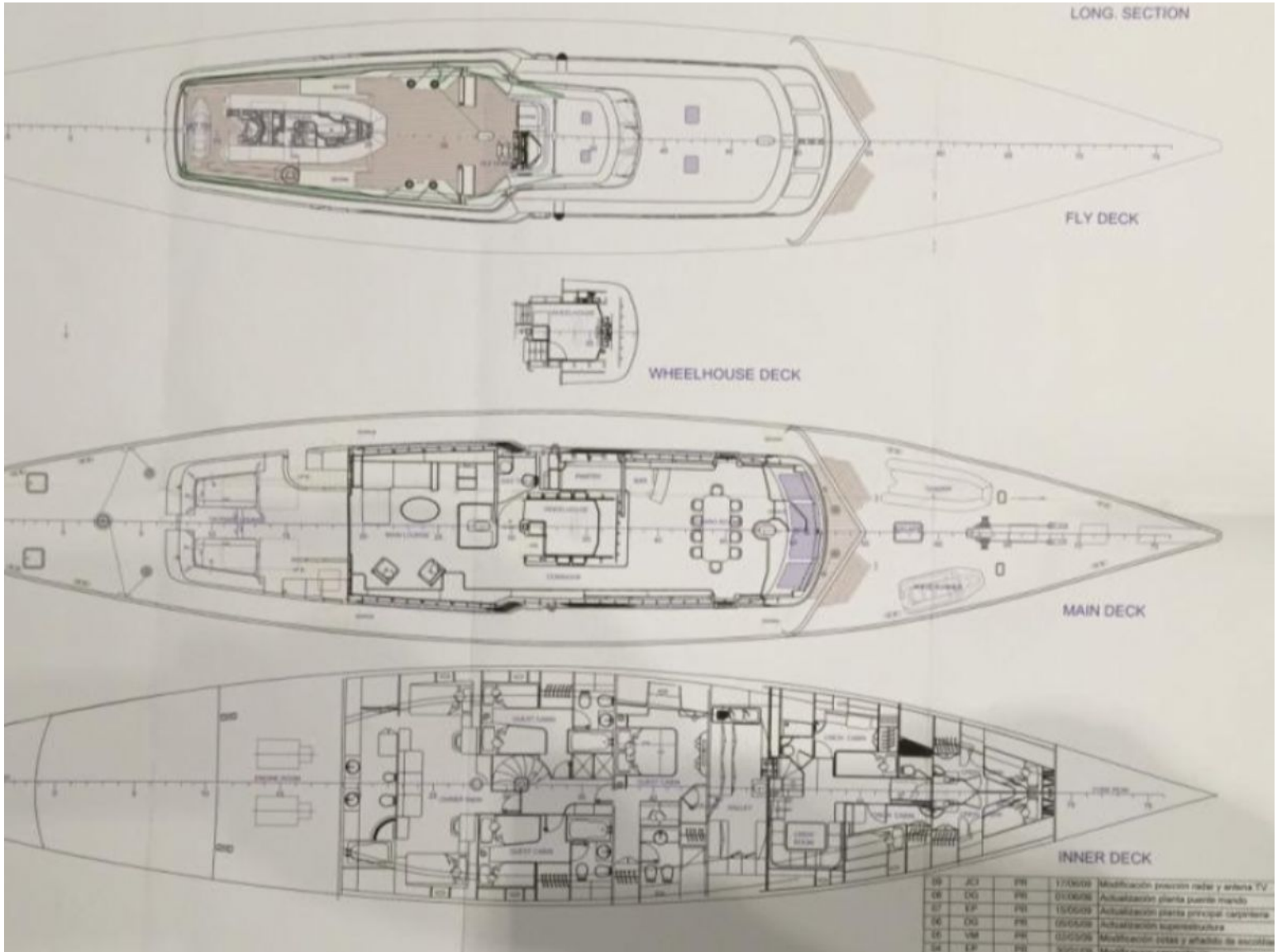
