The interior is built in the renown Dutch traditional style with the changed lay out incorporating the new cabin on the main deck and the relocation of the galley in the main saloon.

Master cabin on the main deck with headroom up to ± 187 cm - bed replaced 2017 with underbed storage. En-suite bathroom with shower.

VIP cabin with King-size bed of 195 x 150 cm, extra bunk berth and headroom up to ± 195 cm.

Spacious en-suite bathroom with toilet and walk in shower.

2 x spacious comfortable cabins twin cabins with headroom up to ± 192 cm and en-suite bathrooms with shower.

Day toilet on main deck

Wheelhouse located on the upper deck with desk and sofa. Access by stairs to saloon. Two observations seats with good visibility and direct access to main deck.

Crew cabin offering berths for a total of 3 crew headroom ca 205 cm and en-suite bathroom. (toilet replaced 2017)

Laundry on main deck with dryer and washing machine and storage space.

Hull repainted (2017)
Superstructure repainted (2020)
Build to Lloyds 100A1 Yacht LMC not under class anymore.
Heavy displacement round bilged, canoe stern construction with flared bow.
Built in approved SM grade 8 mm first sheet closest to keel and 6 mm hull. Steel bulwarks.
5 watertight compartments by 4 bulkheads.
One steel rudder fitted to skeg.
Steel docking/bumper strips.
Stainless steel bow protection plate, anchor hull-shell pocket.

BROKERS COMMENTS:

One of the famous Pacific Class 85 series that was built at Cammenga under Lloyds in 1972 by a design of W. de Vries Lentsch. Steel hull and superstructure with teak decks. Original layout has been changed with master cabin now on the main deck with ensuite bathroom. Below deck she offers 2 guest cabins all with bathrooms ensuite and one king VIP cabin. One crew cabin for 3 persons in the front. Powered by twin Gardners engines each 172 Hp. With the tender on the bow installed many square extra meters are available as deck area resulting in an amazing al Fresco area aft on the flybridge. She is a fine example of a proven timeless solid yacht build in the Netherlands. Her volume and practical layout makes her an ideal family yacht to cruise in style and elegance. Under 24m on paper.

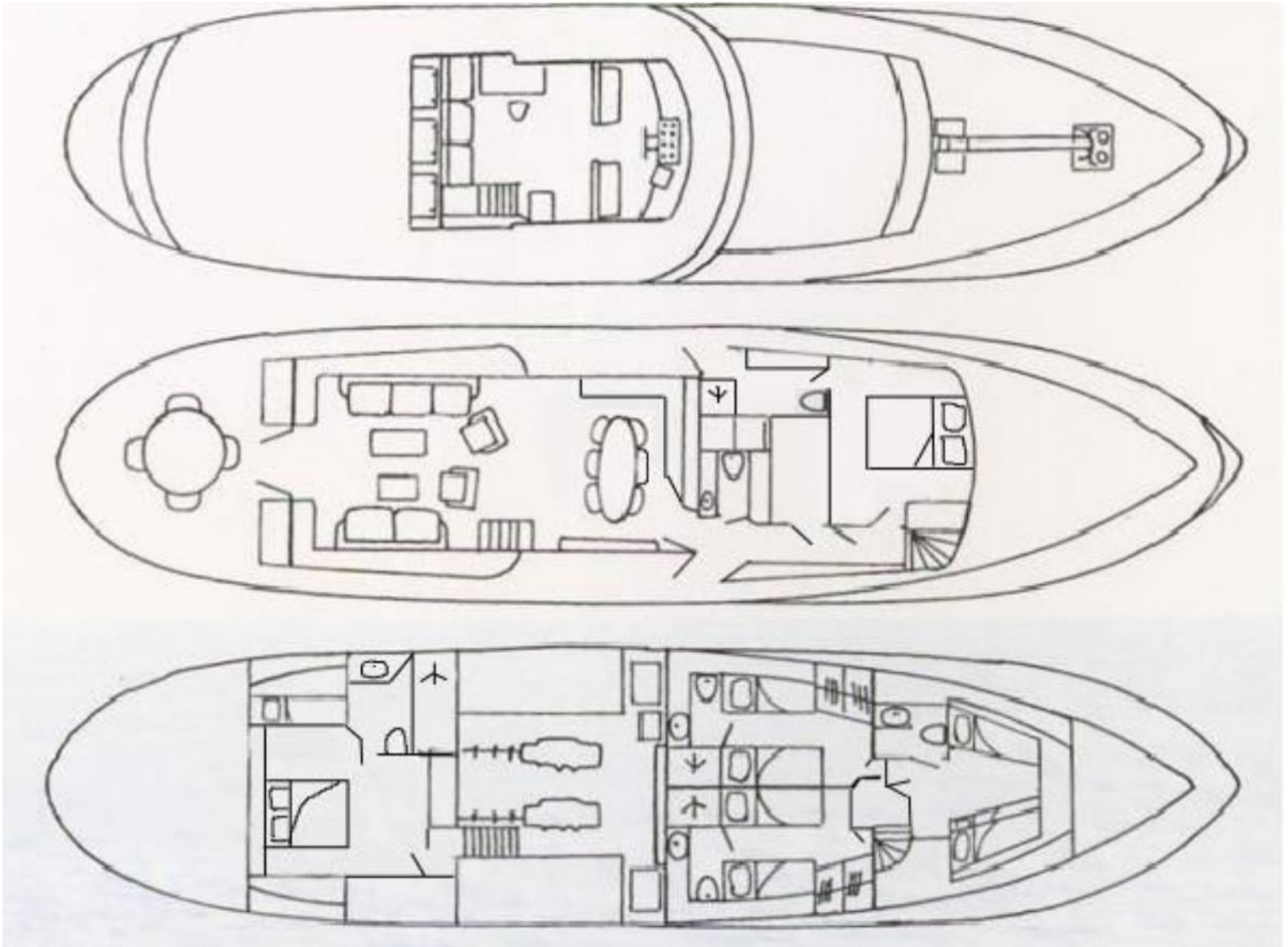
